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About ICLS 2011

The International Congress on Logistics and SCM Systems is organized by the International Federation of Logistics & SCM Systems (IFLS) and the Asian Pacific Federation of Logistics & SCM Systems (APFLS). The 1st Congress was hosted by Waseda University in Tokyo, Japan, November 22-24, 2004, followed by the 2nd Congress hosted by National Kaohsiung First University of Science and Technology in Kaohsiung, Taiwan, May 1-4, 2006. The 3rd Congress was hosted by Kanagawa University in Yokohama, Japan, August 29-31, 2007, the 4th Congress by Asian Institute of Technology in Bangkok, Thailand, November 26-28, 2008, and the 5th Congress by the Korea Society of Supply Chain Management (KSCM) in Convention & Exhibition Center (COEX), Seoul, Korea, June 2-5, 2009. **The 6th International Congress on Logistic and SCM systems, ICLS 2011 will be hosted by College of Management, National Kaohsiung University of Applied Sciences (KUAS) and co-organized by Association for Commercial Modernization in Kaohsiung, Taiwan, March 7-9, 2011.** The congress aims to provide an international forum for leading researchers, educators, software developers, and practitioners to discuss ideas, exchange experiences, and seek opportunities for collaboration on the latest implementation and enhancement of sustainable logistics and SCM systems in the resilient market. This Congress cordially invites papers with academic thinking and industrial successful case examples in logistics and SCM systems field.

Submission

Prospective authors should submit an abstract or full paper, in English, outlining aims, content and conclusion of their papers, as well as other contributions. The abstract or full paper should, include the cover page with a title, topic areas, key words, author name(s), affiliation, mailing address, and the contact information of the corresponding author such as a mailing address, telephone and fax number. The final manuscript for the proceedings would be fine in the formation of MS Word or Power Point slides. **For each accepted paper, at least one of authors with pre-registration is required.** Submissions should be made electronically through the congress website at <http://icls2011.kuas.edu.tw>

Proceedings and Publication

All accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings. Moreover, some selected papers after the conference will be invited for publication in the International Journal of Logistics and SCM System (the official journal of IFLS).
